



Arts in the Park is the annual festival sponsored by The Friends of High School Park. Over the past 15 years our festival has highlighted the display and sale of work from over 50 juried artists and craftspeople. Each year the fair draws people from Elkins Park, Cheltenham Township and neighboring communities to enjoy a day in the Park filled with eye-catching arts and crafts, plant sales, children activities, delicious food, and entertaining music from 10-5 the first Sunday of June.

The Friends of High School Park was established as a completely volunteer organization whose mission is to create, manage and preserve a viable native ecosystem in High School Park for the enjoyment of the community, in cooperation with Cheltenham Township. We are dedicated to inspiring the community to connect with others and the natural environment through service and learning within the park. In 1996, *Arts in the Park* was created to raise funds to carry out the mission.

Festival Information: *Arts in the Park* is open to artists in all media who design and produce their own handcrafted work. No commercially mass-produced items or items for resale will be accepted. Only those items represented by the application samples will be accepted, no additional categories of items by the artist will be allowed to be displayed. Any infringement would ban the artist from future festivals.

Space size - @ 10' x10'. We provide only one space per accepted application. Artists are responsible for supplying his/her own booth or display unit and we recommend canopies for your own comfort. Electricity will NOT be provided. All displays must be set up for the full length of the show. We do not guarantee the same spaces to returning artists. Special requests may be considered for special circumstances.

Jury Procedure and Deadline:

1. Send completed application (below) and payment by 3/1/10, postmark deadline to: FHSP, 7910 Montgomery Avenue, Elkins Park, PA 19027. Please be sure to include your email address for future reference. This will be the last year for a paper application, unless specifically requested. The 2011 application will be emailed.
2. Included with the application should be 4 images on a CD (non-returnable). Actual photographs will be accepted but not preferred. If available you can also email your 4 images to: aip@fhsp.org. Please be sure to mark your complete name and address on the email.
3. The application fees: To Be Included With the Application - 2 checks addressed to Friends of High School Park, check #1 for a \$10 non-refundable application fee, and check #2 for a \$85 booth fee, refundable if artist is not accepted. The booth fee is NOT refundable upon your acceptance.
4. Notifications will be mailed by April 1, 2010. Please include a self addressed stamped envelope for notification.
5. **Sunday, June 6, 2010, 10 AM- 5 PM (Rain date- Sunday June 13, 2010).** In the event of rain, please call the contact listed by 7AM or check the website, www.highschoolpark.org to confirm show status. We will only use the rain date if conditions are severe.
